The Georgia Elks Association/Boska Nursing Scholarship Program is for those that aspire to become nurses, as there is a continuing need for caring and compassionate people in the nursing field.

Dr. Fred Boska bequeathed funds in order to start a program to help Georgia citizens. The Charity Board of the Georgia Elks Association felt that a Nursing Scholarship would satisfy the efforts of Dr. Boska to help his fellowman.

The Boska Scholarship offers up to \$10,000 over a four-year period to help a student become a Registered Nurse with a four-year degree.

How The Program Works

The Georgia Elks Association/Boska Nursing Scholarship is a \$2,500 a year scholarship for up to four years. Upon notification of the successful completion of your year's work, you may apply for the next year.

Our goal is to support you for up to four years to complete your RN degree. This scholarship is only for those who are striving to become a Registered Nurse with a four-year degree.

This scholarship is also available for those who are currently enrolled in an RN program, or are an LPN and would like to become an RN.

Judging is based on: Desire, Grades, Financial Need, and Volunteer Services.

Who Is Eligible

Applicant should be:

Graduating high school senior

GED is acceptable

Current nursing student

An adult wanting a career change

Must live in Georgia

Applicant does *NOT* need to be *related to a member* of the Benevolent & Protective Order of Elks

Applicant does *NOT* need to be a *member* of the Benevolent & Protective Order of Elks
