How

We have 24 lodges in Georgia (about 4,000 Elks). All hands possible from each lodge are requested to meet this need and show how strong our Georgia Elks are when asked to do a job.

A manpower Committee has been appointed in the Local Support Committee that reports to the National Convention Committee to assist in this very important event. The manpower committee has set up a website for volunteers to easily sign up. This is done through a web application called Initlive. Use the QR code below or website link below to access the volunteer sign-up process.

Open your camera, aim at the QR code and when the yellow box **app.initlive.com** pops up, tap it and it will take you to the initlive site.



We ask that each lodge use this code on all communications going to lodge members. It is in the hope that this repetitive process will encourage more volunteers to sign up.

Please identify someone from each lodge that has already used the online volunteer process, Ask them to sign-up others in the their lodge. It is simple and should not take more than about 20 minutes. However, the volunteer can go back in at any time to make changes or add more information. We only need a volunteer to sign up for one four hour shift on any of the days listed. Four hours is a minimum and your registration will be free. More hours would be great, if possible.
